Many of our junior dancers are taking their first exams this term in Class Exam Ballet and Tap with the NATD (National Association of Teachers of Dancing). Whilst exams are not compulsory, they are a wonderful record of achievement, and the children are made to feel very special on the day itself. We wish our junior dancers lots of luck as they begin their exam journey with us.

We also have a set of RAD (Royal Academy of Dance) exams this term and wish all of our Seniors taking their Grade 8 exam, all the very best for this final grade. It honestly feels like no time has passed since they were the juniors, taking their first grades.
